We will be aerifying the greens starting the first of the month (May 7) as well as putting out our cricket control on that day. We will also be aerifying the rest of the course to start the transition to the Bermuda grass.

On May 10<sup>th</sup> we will put out our second pre-emergent (weed control) as well as fertilizing the entire course. Note, the course will remain open.

We will be starting some of the end of the path projects to help with the roughness of the entrance and exits to cart paths.

We have put out our second application for nematode control on the greens. We will be putting up ropes and stakes to help to grow grass in some of the weaker areas.
