Club Championship Format

Club Championship

The following format changes to the Club Championship were discussed by the Golf Committee and agreed upon on June 6, 2018:

Women's Division:

Women will play exclusively from the Silver Tees.

If there are more than 4 foursomes signed up, the division will be split into two flights by handicap (i.e. 0 thru 18 and 19 and greater).

Men's Division:

The Club Championship will be played from the Black Tees if 4 or more players register for the Black Tee. If fewer than 4 players register than the championship will be

played from the Gold Tees. The Club Championship will be determined by gross score, whether played from the Black or Gold tees.

Players may sign up to play from the Gold or Green tees if desired. Each Tee group will be split into at least 2 flights by handicap based on number of people signed up for each Tee (i.e. 0-15; 16-30). The number of flights will be determined by the Committee.

Prize money will be put in a single pool and distributed equally between each Tee Group. There will be a payout to at least the 1st and 2nd place Gross and Net winners in all flights. The number of positions paid will be determined by the Committee.

Reserved Parking Spaces:

The Men's and Women's Club Champions will be awarded their own reserved parking space. The gross winners from each remaining flight will be awarded a shared reserved parking space (2 carts per space).

The areas of weaker turf are impacted first. With very little good top soil in these areas the turf gets heat stress quicker. The turf will recover over time. Since we do not have cart paths everywhere we live with the minimal damage. We have roped off certain areas to try and promote grass from plugs and sod. We will be putting out a material at the end of paths to help these areas also. We will be retreating for Weeds in certain areas also. Have a great summer. Remember stay hydrated and cool.
