One tractor is now operational. We needed to purchase two new turf tires due to cracks in the old tires. The price for the new tires was \$1,660.00.

Fungicide was put out in preparation for the over seeding.

We had some seed that had not been used last year, we were able to return it and get a credit of \$1,823.00. The money was used to purchase additional insecticide.

Terry explained why the cups had been so poorly cut. The new cup cutter had a bad part on it, that made it very difficult to produce a clean cut. They will be using the old cup cutter until the replacement part arrives.

Players need to stay outside of the red lines defining the fairway once the over seeding has been done.

They are discussing what to do about the dead tree behind the green on hole #15.

October is looking like it will be a good month with golf revenue of approximately \$134,000 and F/B doing very well. Member dues will be close to budget.
