The irrigation project is going along well. As of December 22nd, they have finished the entire back 9 greens plus #3 & #8. The remaining greens will be started again on January 2nd.

We are also putting in new satellites & redoing all our programs to make us even more efficient with water & electricity on the entire course.

We are already seeing a savings of 16,340 gallons of water every watering cycle on the greens
