- Fixing some of the low drain boxes along the fairways and cart paths.
- Putting out our 1<sup>st</sup> pre emergent towards the end of this month.
- Fertilizing the course sometime this month.
- Edging all the irrigation heads and valve boxes as well as the yardage blocks and tee blocks.
- Lowering the height on the greens, tees and fairways as the winter grass matures.

Please remember to "<u>DRIVE IN THE</u> <u>FAIRWAYS</u>" as this will help the Bermuda grass in the roughs.
