- Herbicide applications are now being applied on the course. Fairways and rough are currently being treated for goose, crabgrass, broadleaves, and sedges. Tees have been sprayed twice for multiple varieties of weeds. Greens have been treated twice for goose grass. These programs will be ongoing all summer.
- Still fertilizing tees weekly
- July 17th we will be closed for dry jet aerification on greens.
- During July we will be fertilizing the entire course wall to wall.
- Upon completion of aerification we will begin sodding areas that have been dedicated to phase one of sod project. Pre sod preparation will begin asap.
