- We will be treating for weeds as the weather and time allows.
- We will be fertilizing the tees and fairways again this month.
- We are working on cleaning out the beds for the second time this year.
- We are putting out our second pre emergent on tees and fairways this month.

The new pump station is working really well and we are able to use more water more efficiently.
