
MMGA - Mike Russomano

We will be aerifing the greens starting the first of the month (May 7) as well as putting out our cricket control on that day. We will also be aerifing the rest of the course to start the transition to the Bermuda grass.

On May 10th we will put out our second preemergent (weed control) as well as fertilizing the entire course. Note, the course will remain open.

We will be starting some of the end of the path projects to help with the roughness of the entrance and exits to cart paths.

We have put out our second application for nematode control on the greens. We will be putting up ropes and stakes to help to grow grass in some of the weaker areas.
