Greetings from Golf Maintenance Department,

As we enter October, we will continue preparation for over seeding as was explained in last month's newsletter, we have lowered height of cut on fairways, tees, collars and approaches for the first drop and will be lowering at least one more time, possibly two, until the turf's canopy is where it needs to be to receive the seed. We lower HOC in stages to minimize turf stress and surface debris. As mentioned prior, outlining areas with dotted lines will begin this month as well.
