Thanks to Diane Christie for all her hard work and direction on the landscaped beds. We will be putting up ropes around the fairways when we put out our winter grass. Please don't drive in or cross fairways for the two (2) weeks until we get our winter grass established. This is the turf we will have until next summer so we need to get it established. The sod we put in on the greens has taken very well. This will give us a better turf going into the winter season.
